Important notice re: 2020 Adjusted Study Design

Notice last updated 21/08/2020

In 2020, the Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority (VCAA) released an **Adjusted Study Design for VCE Applied Computing** as part of responses to restrictions caused by COVID-19 in Victoria. Most of the content in the DLTV VCE Applied Computing Resource Kit 2020-2024 has been developed according to the *standard* VCE Applied Computing Study Design 2020-2024, not the adjusted one.

When adapting resources from the DLTV Resource Kit, teachers should make the necessary modifications to ensure they are meeting the requirements of the adjusted study design for 2020.

The exception is the **trial examinations** for Software Development and Data Analytics included in the Stage 3 release of the VCE Resource Kit. These have been designed for the adjusted study design, as noted on each cover page.
